#### Policy for students NOT enrolled in a Burnaby school for September

For cancellations received:

- Prior to the commencement of the program, for students whose Visitor/Study Permit is not approved by Citizenship & Immigration Canada, full refund less a \$150 administration fee. Students must include the letter of rejection from the Canadian Embassy.
- 14 days or more prior to the start of the program, 80% refund.
- 1-13 days prior to the start of the program, 50% refund.
- No refund for requests made after the start of the program, including for students departing early from the program or their homestay.
- No refund for students removed from the program.

#### Policy for students enrolled in a Burnaby school for September

For cancellations received:

- Prior to the commencement of the program, for students whose Visitor/Study Permit is not approved by Citizenship & Immigration Canada, full refund less a \$75 administration fee. Students must include the letter of rejection from the Canadian Embassy.
- 21 days or more prior to the start of the program, full refund less a \$150 administration fee.
- 14-20 days prior to the start of the program, full refund less \$250 administration fee.
- 1-13 days prior to the start of the program, 80% refund.
- No refund for requests made after the start of the program, including for students departing early from the program or their homestay.
- No refund for students removed from the program.

Students who do not receive their Study Permit and/or Visitor Visa prior to the start of their program can defer to the next program start date. Notice must be given a minimum two weeks prior to the commencement of their initial program.

#### **Photographs**

A photographer will be taking photos of student activities for future promotional materials, including the website. By enrolling your child in the program you are authorizing your child to be included in these photographs.

Various modes of transportation may be used including public transport. Students will be supervised by an adult but not necessarily at all times.

We, the undersigned, do waive and release all claims against the Burnaby School District #41 for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or expense resulting from the applicant's participation in the district's International Summer English Language Academy. We also release the Burnaby School District and agree to indemnify them, with regard to any financial obligation or liabilities that the applicant may cause while participating in the program. We understand that the Burnaby School District is not responsible for any loss or injury suffered by the applicant during periods of travel. We understand that the applicant's participation in the program may be terminated at the discretion of the Managing Director of International Education or designate without any refund of fees, and that the applicant may be sent home at his or her own expense if he or she violates school or homestay rules, the district codes of conduct, or the laws of BC and/or Canada.
